



Dress Code Policy

Policy:

Students are to comply with the Dress Code for all in-school and out-of- school classes, public occasions and excursions. In the event of a student not being dressed appropriately and his/her parents cannot be reached, students will be provided with something to wear by the school.

General Rules:

1. No hats and/or headgear will be worn in the school building at any time (except for religious purposes).
2. All outdoor clothing is to be removed and placed in the changing room during the school day.
3. Antislip house shoes must be worn in school at all times (except for students who require medical insoles).
4. During PE lessons children must change into appropriate PE clothes.
5. Every Monday, and during field trips or excursions, students have to wear the school shirt and/or the school hoody.
6. For safety reasons, no large earrings and nail extensions are allowed.

Some examples of inappropriate attire are:

- Exposed stomachs or backs, clothes that are revealing
 - Exposed undergarments, including see-through garments
 - Low-cut tops, strapless clothing, pajamas
