



MYP Dress Code Policy

Updated June 2021

Policy:

Students are to comply with the Dress Code for all in-school and out-of-school classes, public occasions and excursions. In the event of a student not being dressed appropriately and his/her parents cannot be reached, students will be provided with something to wear by the school.

General Rules:

1. No hats and/or headgear will be worn in the school building at any time (except for religious purposes).
2. All outdoor clothing is to be removed and placed in the student's locker during the school day.
3. Antislip house shoes must be worn in school at all times (except for students who require medical insoles).
4. During PE lessons children must change into appropriate PE clothes and shoes. Long hair needs to be tied back. For safety reasons, all jewelry must be removed before the PE class begins.
5. Every Monday and Tuesday students have to wear the school shirt and/or the school hoodie in any colour sold in the school's shop (dark green, dark blue, black, grey and white; and the NASA shirt)

6. During field trips or excursions students have to wear the dark green shirt and/or school hoodie.
7. For safety reasons, no large earrings and nail extensions are allowed.

Some examples of unacceptable attire are:

- Exposed stomachs or backs, low-cut tops, strapless clothing
 - Exposed undergarments, including see-through garments
 - Finger-tip length shorts and skirts
 - Ripped clothing
 - Pajamas
 - Excessive Make-up
 - Note: Tank tops are allowed if the straps cover the undergarment.
