MYP/DP Dress Code Policy - updated for the 2026/27 school year

Students are to comply with the Dress Code for all in-school and out-of-school classes, public occasions, and school/class excursions.

Dress Code: ABIS School Shirt (Effective Week 2, 2026/27 School Year)

- **Loaner Policy:** Failure to wear the school shirt requires changing into a school-provided T-shirt.
- **Return Policy:** Students must return the t-shirt before leaving school grounds.
- **Cleaning Fee:** A €5 maintenance fee applies to every loan.
- **Lost Item Fee:** A €20 replacement fee applies if the shirt is not returned.
- **Notification:** Parents receive an automatic notification for every incident.

Dress Code Must-Haves:

- Students have to wear the school t-shirt (unmodified) in any colour sold in the school's shop every day: <https://www.abis.school/abis-uniform-online-shop/>
- During field trips or excursions, students must wear the green t-shirt and hoodie.
- All outdoor clothing is to be removed and placed in the student's locker during the school day.
- House shoes/slippers must be worn in school (*except for students who require medical insoles*).
 - All students who transition campuses may wear outside shoes downstairs, but **MUST** change into house shoes before coming upstairs.
- Underwear must be covered by clothing.
- Ripped jeans, pants, or tights are not appropriate wear for school.
- Shorts and skirts are acceptable wear for school, but all necessary body parts and undergarments shall be covered.
- During PE lessons, children must change into appropriate PE clothes and shoes. Long hair needs to be tied back and all jewelry must be removed before the PE class begins.



- Clothes should be appropriate for the learning environment and daily activities.
- For safety reasons, no earrings, larger than 20 mm, and nail extensions are allowed at all times. Nail extensions should not be longer than 0.5 cm measured from the fingertip.
- Smartwatches and mobile phones must be switched off throughout the school day.

Dress Code Don'ts:

- No hats and/or headgear will be worn in the school building at any time.
- No pajamas
- No clothing with inappropriate words or images
- No accessories that could be considered dangerous or harmful to self or others
- No bare feet or only socks.

While fashion and style may change over time, the purpose of attending school remains the same: students are here to learn. Any clothing or accessories that disrupt the learning environment will not be allowed. If a student's appearance causes a disruption or poses a risk to themselves or others, they will not be allowed to participate in class or activities until the issue is addressed.

The Role of Parents

Parents are expected to support the school uniform policy by ensuring their children are correctly dressed and prepared for the school day.
